*For the past 90 years, the League of Women Voters has worked to inform and educate voters. Some resources to help you evaluate candidates and ballot measures are:*

- Check candidate information on the Smart Voter website [www.smartvoter.org](http://www.smartvoter.org).
- Read statements on candidates and ballot measures in your voter handbook.
- Attend candidate debates or watch them on Comcast (Xfinity) cable channels 26 and 27 and AT&T U-Verse Channel 99.
- Read about issues on the Marin League's website [www.marinlwv.org](http://www.marinlwv.org).
- Find out who's endorsing or opposing the candidate or ballot measure.
- Critically examine campaign mailing pieces, door hangers, emails and handouts:
  - Does the material contain personal attacks, ridicule the candidate, contain statements that can't be verified or employ scare tactics?
  - Who sent you this material? The candidate? An unknown source?
  - Are you receiving a large number of mailing pieces attacking a candidate or ballot measure?
  - Are the sponsors clearly identified as individuals or just as a committee?
  - Beware of phone calls asking biased questions about a specific candidate.



**Above all: Watch out for last-minute hit pieces.**
